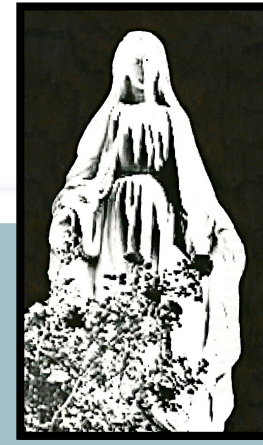

***Emcee Needed**...our Emcee is moving so we will need a person or two to take this position. Also, someone to sing the National Anthem!

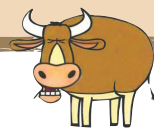
***Kitchen and Pit**...We still need 5 spots to be filled for the 2-6 kitchen shift and quite a few spots at the pit on Sunday.

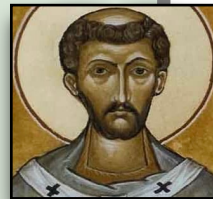

A Message from Father Rick



Father was away on vacation and I found some interesting facts about the Trinity...here they are...

*The term "Trinity" was first used in the 2nd century by Theophilus of Antioch, a convert to Christianity. However, Theophilus did not use the words "Father", "Son", or "Holy Spirit".

*The First Council of Nicaea, formed in AD 325, was a group of bishops who were based in what is now Turkey. They confirmed the use of the term "Trinity", particularly regarding the ideas of God as Father and Son.

*The First Council of Constantinople confirmed the nature and role of the Holy Spirit in AD 381.

*This understanding of the Trinity as referring to God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit has continued to be a very important part of the Christian faith.
