

A Message **L** from Father Rick

Hippocrates was an ancient Greek physician who lived during Greece's Classical period and is traditionally regarded as the father of medicine. He said, "Healing is a matter of time, but it is sometimes also a matter of opportunity." Indeed, for those who are suffering from any form of illness, every opportunity to get better should be availed. The Gospel this Sunday tells two stories of healing. It tells the story of a woman suffering for a very long time. Her pain and suffering cannot be seen from outside. She did not get any sympathy from the crowd. When she saw Jesus, she knew her opportunity had come. Jesus said to her later when she knew she was healed, "Daughter, your faith has saved you." In the parallel story of healing, Jesus also said to the synagogue official whose child was reported to be dead already, "Do not be afraid; just have faith." How blessed were these people to be given the opportunity to encounter Jesus and get the healing they needed. Yes, healing is sometimes a matter of opportunity, but Jesus is also teaching us that healing is also a matter of having faith and courage. Fear and unbelief do not just deprive us from healing; they also cause us to suffer even more. I pray that we will always have the courage and faith, never giving up every opportunity to be healed and heal others.

*Peter's Pence


