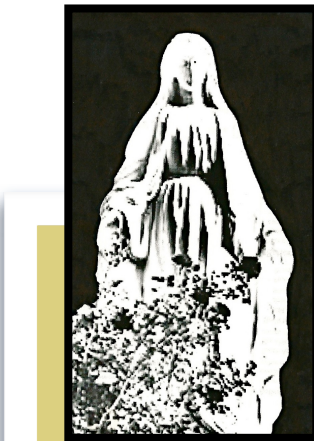

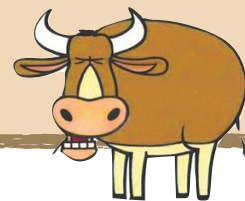

A Message from Father Rick



The best thing about Jesus was that he knew and felt what people really needed even without being told. Jesus knew more than anybody else the reality of hunger. He once spent forty days without food in the desert and the Gospel writer said, "He was hungry." Jesus too was a breadwinner of his family. After the death of St. Joseph, he took care of his mother and earned his living as a village carpenter. He knew the difficulty of working and earning so he could provide the most basic need of the family – food. Often times, there is simply not enough. How a few loaves and a handful of fish can feed thousands of people? Jesus has the answer. The disciples, faced with the impossible, obeyed and trusted in His words. The miracle of the multiplication of the bread happened as the result of the disciples' obedience of faith. The people were fed not just with bread but with the spirit of true fellowship. May our communion in the Holy Eucharist today satisfy our hunger for God and provide us with our most basic necessities in life.

*Mass Intentions...many dates available

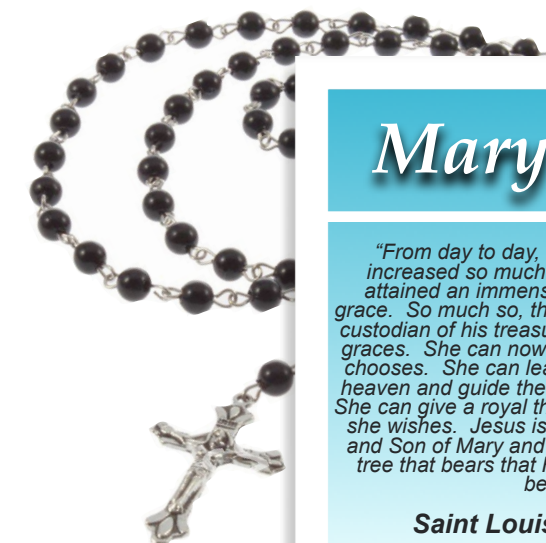
