

ministry of Jesus. Since He began his public life, Jesus never stayed in one place. He moved constantly from one place to another, even going to places that were non-Jews or gentiles. Jewish people generally hated the gentiles even calling them "fuels for the fires of hell." Jesus challenged such attitude and ministered to the gentiles. The healing of the deaf and dumb person in this Sunday's Gospel was one example. Jesus showed his sensitivity to the deaf person by taking him aside. Then Jesus started the process of healing which was different from other healings he had performed. Jesus could have just said a word or two and the person would be healed. But no, He had to lead the man away from the crowd, put his fingers into the man's ears, spit on his own fingers, touched the man's tongue with the spittle, looked up to heaven, groaned and spoke the healing command: "Ephphatha" ("be opened"). What Jesus had done was not simply healing the person of his physical defect. Jesus showed the concrete manifestations of the transformative power of the Love of God. May we learn to truly love and care as Jesus did.
