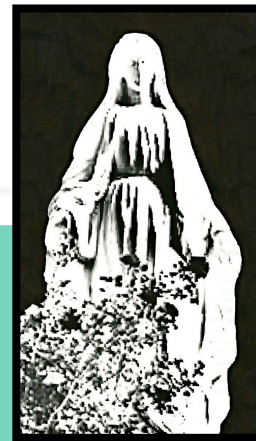

*Catholic Chat...next Sunday, October 20

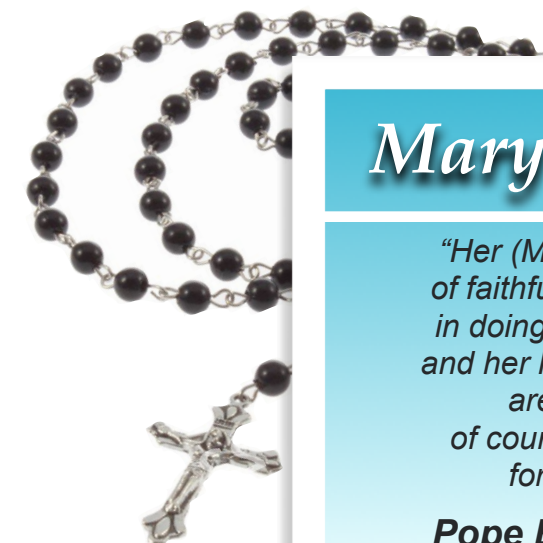
