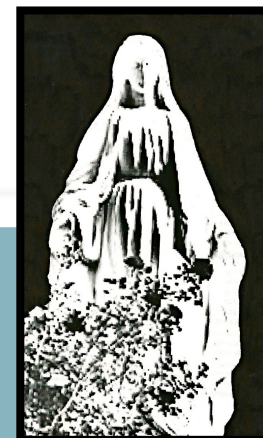

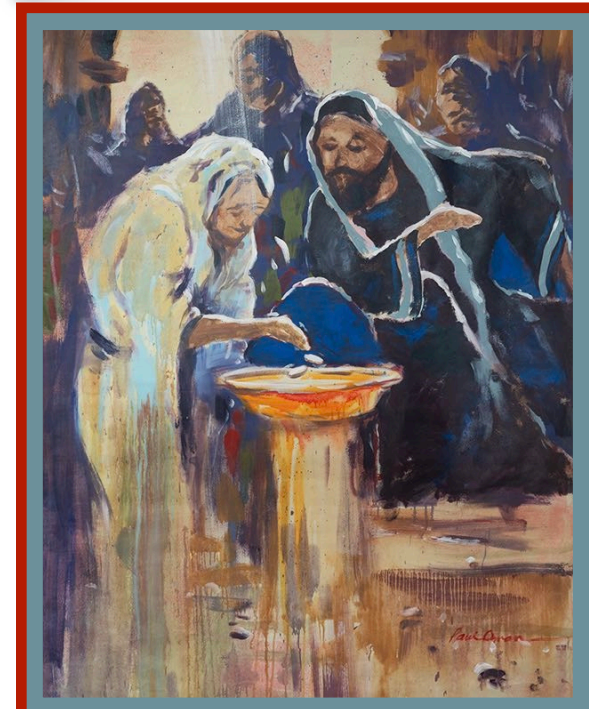

A Message from Father Rick

The story of the Prophet Elijah and the widow in the city of Zarephath was a story of a strange exchange of gifts. Elijah and the widow both gave gifts to each other, gifts that they did not possess. The woman and her only son were at the point of death because of famine. Elijah was starving after a long journey. All she had was the last scoop of flour and the last drop of oil. She on one hand could not reasonably offer Elijah anything to eat. On the other hand Elijah had nothing to give except his prayer and trust in the Lord. Yet in the end, she rendered hospitality to Elijah and her act did not go unrewarded. The story the poor widow in the Gospel who gave all she had to the temple also reminds us what true giving means. Our generosity, either to the Church or to the poor should come from the depths of our heart. We give even if we know it is the last because it is the right thing to do. God cannot be outdone in generosity. God cannot let the jar of flour go empty and the jug of oil run dry. God has always something in store for those who truly give from their hearts.

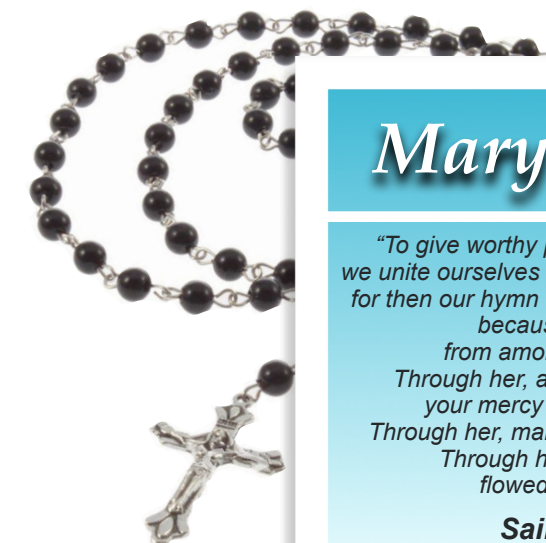
