





A Message from Father Rick



A story is told during the Second World War about a group of soldiers who came to a little Italian village which was heavily devastated. They stumbled upon a statue of Christ lying on the ground broken into several pieces. The soldiers tried to put back the statue as best as they could and place it on the pedestal. But they could not find the hands of the statue. Finally, one of the soldiers made a note and placed it near the statue. The note read: "I have no hands but yours." Today, as we celebrate the feast of Christ the King, we read John's account of Jesus having been interrogated by Pilate. Yes, Jesus is King. But his kingdom is different from all the kings and kingdoms of this world. Jesus is the King of the "Kingdom of God". Many times Jesus spoke of the kingdom of God as the central theme of his ministry. Christ is King and his kingdom is here and now. Today we once again claim his Kingship in our lives. We pledge our allegiance to the Lord and strive to be His hands and feet, becoming agents of his love and mercy for others.


The Mass in remembrance of her will be celebrated here on Wednesday, November 27 at 10 AM.
