

# A Message from Father Rick

Jesus wants his disciples to love not just any kind of loving but the kind of love which is special and unique. Jesus' commandments to give and to forgive are difficult and impossible. Jesus himself assured us in the Gospel. "I will be with you until the end to time." We have the assurance of the abiding divine presence of Jesus in our struggle to love, to give, and to forgive. The grace that we receive through our prayers. celebrations of the sacraments and through our good works makes the difference. It is grace and the presence of Christ in our midst that make us unique and special. Therefore, we continue to strive to give and to forgive even if at times it seems impossible. In one of his sermons, St. Augustine of Hippo describes Jesus precepts of giving and forgiving as two essential wings of prayer. "Let us graciously and fervently perform these two types of almsgiving, that is, giving and forgiving, for we in turn pray the Lord to give us things and not to repay our evil deeds" (Sermon 206.2).
